Operator took this test over from Aztec Oil & Gas Company after it had been plugged back to a depth of 3496'. We attempted tests in the Seven Rivers section through casing perforations from 3336' to 3356'; 3130' to 3140' and 3158' to 3170'. After prolonged testing it was shown that commercial production could not be obtained so decision was made to plug and abandon pursuant to the notice of such submitted under date of February 2, 1966.

We filled the 9-5/8" casing with six and one-half yards of 5/8" gravel and then capped this with two yards of cement grout (1 to 5). We then set a wood plug in the 9-5/8" casing at a depth of 20 feet from the surface and filled this interval back to surface with cement grout. Six feet of four inch pipe was set in the cement grout and extended four feet above ground level. Name and location of well was welded on pipe by a raised welded bead. Cellar, and pits had been covered when Operator took over from Aztec Oil & Gas.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.
