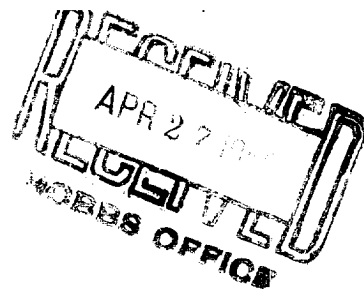

Re-cemented 5½" casing @ 4275' with 200 sacks 4% gel cement April 19, 1950.
Moved out rotary. Moved in and rigged up cable tools.
Drilled out cement from 4250' to 4300' April 16, 1950 and tested casing satisfactorily by bailing method.
Drilled out cement and cal-seal from 4300' to 4310'.
Cleaned out to corrected plug back depth of 4440'.
