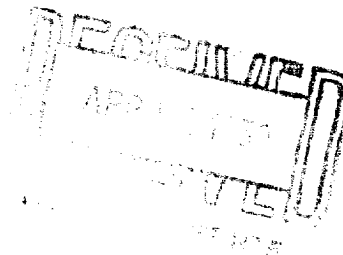

Re-acidized w/3000 gal. reg. acid, April 2, 1950, and swabbed 2 bbls. oil/hr.

Re-acidized w/10,000 gal. reg. acid April 4, 1950, and swabbed 4 bbls fluid per hour cutting 50% with acid and formation water.
