Gentlemen:


Please refer to your letter of June 5, 1956 granting us authority to flare gas from the above described well, and requesting that we furnish a progress report prior to September 4, 1956 showing our efforts to eliminate the flaring of gas from this well.

You are advised that the volume of gas being produced from this well is very low, and a large percentage of same is being used in the operation of the lease, such as gas for the motor on the pumping unit and gas used in the heater-treater to treat the oil, and the remaining gas is being flared to the burning pit. Just recently a representative of the gas department of Phillips Petroleum Company was on the lease and made a test of the amount of gas being flared and we were advised that an insufficient amount of gas was being flared to warrant the laying of a line for same to the lease.
