

Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of June 21, 1960, concerning violation of Rules 201 and 1106 of the Commission Rules and Regulations in the plugging operation and late filing of Form C-103 on our Amerada State No. 2, Unit O, Section 1, T-22-S, R-35-E.

By way of explanation, this is to advise that we purchased all outstanding stock of the Reaho Corporation and assumed operation of the properties on June 1, 1958. The Amerada State No. 2 had been abandoned prior to this time and we accordingly assumed that the necessary reports had been filed long before.

Your Mr. Joe D. Ramey's request for Form C-103 was our first knowledge that all was not in order, and from information in our files we promptly filed the requested Form C-103.

In addition to your letter, we have also received a form letter from the New Mexico Commission dated June 20, 1960, advising that Form C-102 was approved May 1, 1957, and that Form C-103 cannot be approved until a Commission representative has inspected the location. This letter is signed by Mr. Leslie A. Clements, Oil and Gas Inspector, and would possibly indicate compliance with Rule 201 by the previous owners of Reaho Corporation.

It appears that we should file a corrected C-103 showing the proper plugging date, and have the location checked and put in order for inspection. By copy of this letter we are instructing our Jal District Superintendent, Mr. William Fink, to do these things immediately, and to advise Mr. Clements when it is ready for inspection. If any other action is necessary under the Commission Rules and Regulations, please advise and we will promptly comply.
