
Gentlemen:

Gentlemen:

We hereby ask for administrative approval for an exception to the No Flare Order R-520, Paragraph 10, to be made for our Atlantic State No. 1 well located in the SE/4 of the SE/4, Section 3, T-22-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The gas volume from this well is insufficient to run the flow treater and the pumping unit, and Phillips Petroleum Company has advised that it is not economically feasible to lay a line for this well, which is approximately 6,000 feet from the nearest casinghead gas gathering line.

We enclose herewith a plat showing offset well locations and point of nearest sales connection.

We respectfully request that this exception be granted until such time as we are able to make arrangements for the disposal of the casinghead gas.
