Gentlemen:

We hereby ask for administrative approval for an exception to the No Flare Order R-520, Paragraph 10, be made for our Phillips State No. 1. This well is located in the NW/4 of the NE/4, Section 10, T-22S, R-35E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Phillips Petroleum Company has expressed interest in purchasing gas from the lease but feel that it is not economically feasible to lay a line for the one well. They have assured us that the completion of a second well on this lease in the near future would make it possible for them to give us a gas connection.

The volume of gas to be flared, based on our initial potential, will be approximately 12 MCF per day. The gas-oil ratio is 387 to 1.

Phillips Petroleum Company now has a gas line approximately one mile from our tank battery.

We enclose herewith a plat showing the well location, operator ownership, and the location of the tank battery.

We request this exception for a period of 120 days, or such a time that we may complete our No. 2 well.



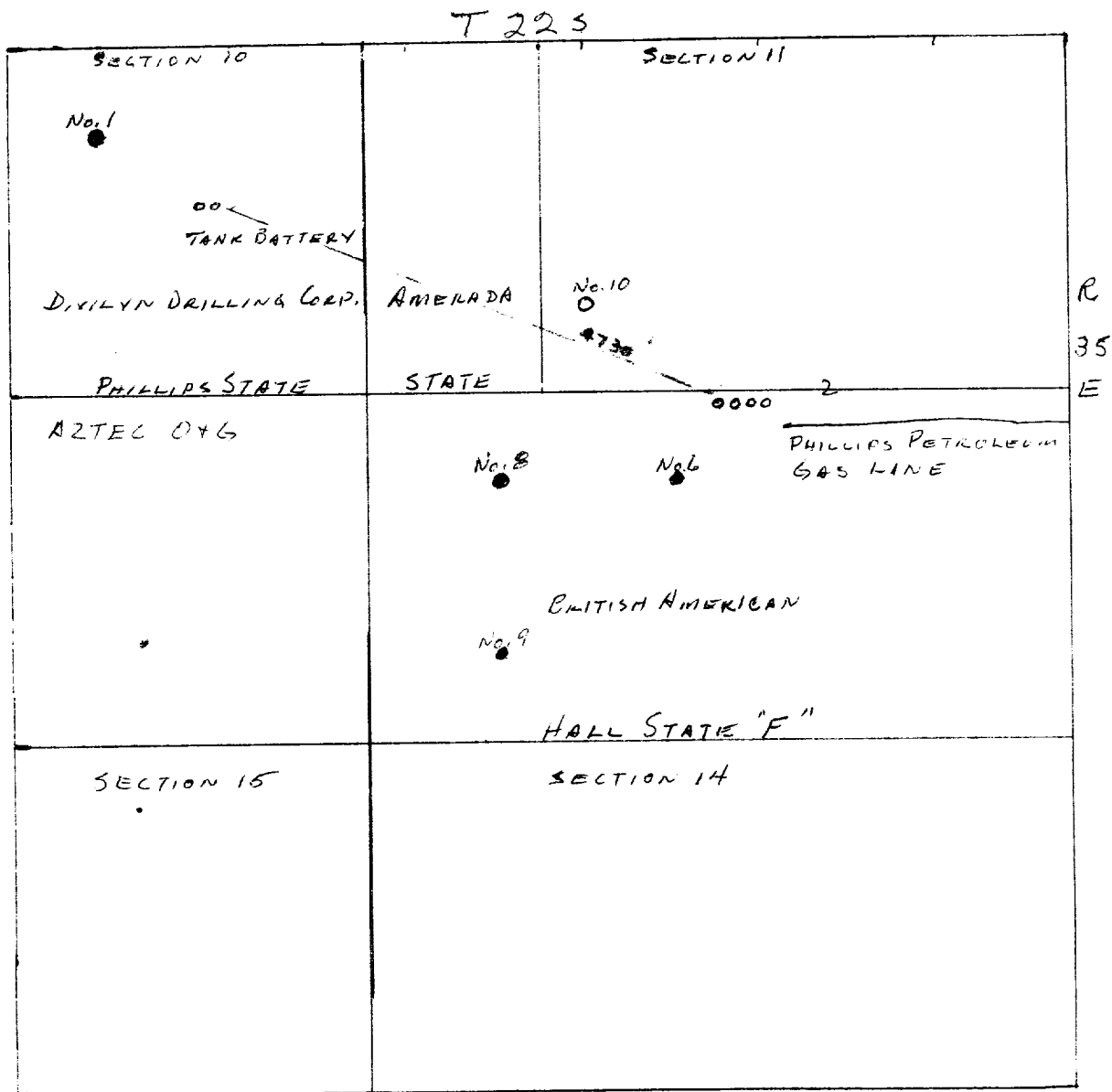
