Bex 871 Santa Fe, New Mexico Re: Request for extension of Order NFO-434 pertaining to the Flaring of Gas in the Jalmat Pool, Lea County, New Mexico Centlemen: Amerada Petroleum Corporation hereby makes application for an extension of Order NFO-434 permitting Amerada to flare casinghead gas on the State WE"J" Lease in the Jalmat Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts: (1) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation is the owner and operator of the State WE"J" Lease located in the W/2 of the NW/4 of Section 1.1, T-22-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The State WE"J" No. 1 located 660' from the west line and 1980' from the south line of Section 11 has been producing as an oil well in the Jalmat Pool since July 12, 1958 and the State WE"J" No. 2 located 660' from the north line and 990' from the east line of Section 11 is now being completed as an oil well in the Jalmat Pool. (2) That by provision of Order NFO-434. Amerada Petroleum Corporation was granted permission to vent casinghead gas from the State WE"J" No. 1 until February 3, 1959. (3) That Phillips Petroleum Company has announced their intention of laying a line to take casinghead gas from the above wells inte their les pressure gas gathering system. (4) That by approximately 90 days after February 3, 1959, this gathering line should be laid and a connection made so that it will not be necessary to flare casinghead gas on this lease. In view of the facts stated above, Amerada Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests that the Secretary of the Commission grant a 90 day extension to Order NFO-434 so that it will not be necessary to shut this well in until the gas connection is made.
