Gentlemen:

Your letter of September 1, 1956, requested that The British-American Oil Producing Co. furnish you a progress report concerning efforts to eliminate venting or flaring gas from Hall State "F" No. 1, located in the SE/4, SE/4 of Section 11, T-22-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

We have contacted Phillips Petroleum Company concerning connecting this well and taking gas. Photostatic copy of their reply is attached which states their position in not making a gas connection. We trust that this will be ample information for your records. Because of the economic limitations Phillips, at present, cannot connect; therefore, it will be necessary that British-American continue venting gas from the Hall State "F" No. 1 until economics justify a connection.
