DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth 4045 feet. Ran 124 joints (3958 feet) 5 1/2-inch, 15.5 and 17 pound, J-55, seamless casing and cemented at 3967 feet in two stages; 150 sacks containing 1/2 pound Flocele per sack around shoe; and, 100 sacks neat cement through two-stage collar at 1688 feet (top Rustler Anhydrite 1655 feet, top of Salt 1800 feet). Plug down at 6:50 PM, May 4, 1954. WOC 48 hours. Drilled top plug. Tested casing with 1000 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Washed to 3918 feet. Did not drill bottom plug.
