## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 4040 feet. Ran 122 joints (4018 feet) 5½-inch OD, 15.5-pound, J-55, seamless, 8 Rd thread, LT&G, new casing. Cemented casing at 4027 feet with 700 sacks (600 1:1 Halliburton Pozmix plus 4% bentonite and 100 sacks neat). Plug down at 5:07 PM, May 25, 1955. WOC 36 hours. Cleaned out casing to 3987 feet; did not drill plug. Tested casing with 1000 psi for 60 minutes. No pressure loss. Proceeded to perforate casing and complete well.
