Spudded 12 1/4-inch hole at 4:00 PM, June 22, 1956. Drilled to total depth 305 feet in red beds. Ran 9 joints (289 feet) 3 5/8-inch OD, 24-pound, J-55, EW and seamless, 8 Rd thd, ST&C, new casing with Texas pattern shoe. Cemented casing at 301 feet with 150 sacks Halliburton 1:1 Pozmix and cement. Plug down 12:00 midnight June 22-23, 1956. Cement circulated. WOC 24 hours. Down 2 1/2 days repairing rig. Tested casing with 500 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and drilled 7 7/8-inch hole ahead.
