FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
 (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

To increase production we propose to do the following work.

1. Perforate 4-1/2" casing with two jet shots per foot at the following intervals:
 3783' to 3820' & 3840' to 3876'.
2. Acidize perforations from 3783' to 3876' with 1000 gallons LST-NE 15% acid down
 2" tubing with packer and acidizing tool at approximately 3885'. (Breakdown new
 Perforations.)
3. Fracture perforations from 3783' to 3930 with 20,000 gallons refined oil carrying
 1-1/2 pounds of sand per gallon in two stages employing temporary plugging material.
4. Swab well, recover load oil, test, and return well to production.
