DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

All 11" hole was drilled to 5850' and 8-5/8" 28 1/2 lb casing cemented at 5849' with 2200 sks w/4% gel, 100 sks neat, 100 bags perlite material. Cement was circulated to the surface. The plug was down at 1:45 pm 5-9-51. Drilling operations were resumed after 48 hours WOC time at which time the casing was pressure tested and found to be satisfactory.
