DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

We ran 120 joints, 3854' of 5 1/2", 15.50# J-55 casing landed @ 3849' and cemented with 600 sacks of poxmix 4% Gel by Halliburton. Plug down @ 5 P.M. September 14, 1956. After allowing the cement to set 48 hours, the casing was tested to 1000# and pressure held for 30 minutes with no drop recorded. Float collar and plug drilled and again tested to 1000# and held for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Mud displaced with oil. Completion work to begin September 20, 1956.
