DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was spudded @ 5:30 P.M. September 5, 1956. We ran 276.53' of 8 5/8" - 28# casing landed @ 292' and cemented with 225 sack neat cement. Cement circulated. Plug down @ 11 P.M. After allowing the cement to set 24 hours, 1000# pressure was applied and held for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure recorded. The plug was then drilled and 1000# pressure applied, held for 30 minutes, no drop recorded. Drilling ahead resumed.
