DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 4010 feet in dolomite. Ran 125 joints (4000 feet) 5 1/2-inch OD; 20, 17 and 15.5 pound, seamless, J-55, second hand and new casing. Cemented casing at 4010 feet with 1100 sacks (1000 sacks 1:1 cement and Halliburton Pozmix with 6% bentonite plus 20 pounds salt per sack; followed by 100 sacks neat cement). Cement circulated. Plug down 11:10 PM, May 9, 1955. WOG 36 hours. Cleaned out to 3964 feet - did not drill out entire plug. Tested casing with 800 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss.
