well is approximately three-fourths of a mile to the northwest. This line belonging to the Phillips Petroleum Company system is presently taking it's full capacity of casinghead gas. Negotiations with Phillips Petroleum Company are continuing and they have stated that they might build a new line into the area.

The gas-oil ratio for this well is 700:1. The gas volume to be flared would be 29.4 MCF per day with an allowable of 42 barrels.
