Gentlemen:

Herewith is submitted in triplicate, application for
exception to the "No-Flare Order" for the above captioned
well.

The complete legal description of the lease
involved is the SE/4 of Section 24, Twp. 22S,
Rge. 35E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Five wells have been completed on this lease,
No. 1 being a gas well 1,980' from the south and 660'
from the east lines of Section 24; No. 2 being an
oil well 1,980' from the south and east lines of
Section 24; No. 3 being an oil well 330' from the
south line and 2,310' from the east line of Sec-
tion 24; No. 4 being the above captioned well, 660'
from the south and 990' from the east lines of
Section 24 and No. 5 being 1,980' from the south
and 990' from the east lines of Section 24.

Attached is a plat which shows the well and
lease location, offset ownership and low pressure
gas lines in the area.

Permission is requested to flare the casinghead gas pro-
duced with the oil until such time as a low pressure gas line
connection is obtained. The nearest gathering system to this

well is approximately three-fourths of a mile to the northwest. This line belonging to the Phillips Petroleum Company system is presently taking it's full capacity of casinghead gas. Casinghead gas contracts have been signed with Phillips, and they state that they will have completed an additional low pressure line which will be connected to the above captioned well sometime in July 1968.

The gas-oil ratio for this well is 940:1. The gas volume to be flared would be 35.7 MCF per day with an allowable of 33 barrels.
