Drilled to 333'. Ran 10 joints of 8-5/8" casing. Total 320.03' set at 332.53'. Halliburton cemented with 300 sacks of regular cement with 3% calcium chloride. Plug down to 302' at 11:30 PM 10-4-56. Cement circulated. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes OK. Drilled plug and pumped into formation at 850#. Resumed drilling.
