Dear Mr. Key:

The past-tense wording of Form C-102 on this well leads me to believe subject well is already "abandoned", so this is to inform you that the well is standing improperly plugged.

Following is a proposed plan for proper plugging and abandoning of subject well:

1. 15 sacks cement at TD
  2. 25 sacks cement at base of salt section
  3. 25 sacks cement at base (in & out) of 9-5/8" surface casing
  4. 30 feet cement in top of 9-5/8" surface casing w/proper marker installed.
- Mud laden fluid between all plugs in accordance with Rule 202 of the General Rules and Regulations of the N.M.O.C.C. Please refer also to Rules 201 and 204.

Your proposed plan of plugging, whether it be the one proposed above or another similar plan of your choosing, should be submitted on Form C-102 to this office as soon as possible. If there are any questions concerning this well please call this office.
