low pressure gas line connection is obtained. The nearest gathering system to this well is approximately 1 1/4 miles to the northwest. This line belonging to the Phillips Petroleum Company is presently taking its full capacity of casinghead gas. Negotiations with Phillips are continuing and they have stated that they are considering building a new line into the area.

The gas-oil ratio for this well is 840:1. The gas volume to be flared would be 36.1 MCF per day with an allowable of 43 barrels.
