gathering system to this well is approximately 1 1/4 miles to the northwest. This line belonging to the Phillips Petroleum Company system is presently taking it's full capacity of casinghead gas. Casinghead gas contracts have been signed with Phillips, and they state that they will have completed an additional low pressure line which will be connected to the above captioned well sometime in July 1957.

The gas-oil ratio for this well is 800:1. The gas volume to be flared would be 30.4 MCF per day with an allowable of 38 barrels.
