Re: Application for Exception to No-
Flare Order R-553
Eogle Oil Company
Schermmerhorn State No. 1

Gentlemen:

Application is hereby made for an exception to Order R-553 to flare casinghead gas from Eogle Oil Company Schermmerhorn State No. 1, located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 36, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, Jalmat Oil Pool.

In support of this application we submit the following facts:

A gas-oil ratio test was run April 15, 1961 and the above described well produced 10 barrels oil and 5 barrels water with a gas-oil ratio of 1000/1.

The well is produced every other day. On this basis 10 MCF gas is flared on producing days or an average of 5 MCF per day, 150 MCF per month.

The nearest low pressure gathering system is Phillips Petroleum Company approximately 100 yards from the tank battery.

The volume of gas available for sale is insufficient to make the installation of necessary lines and facilities economically feasible.

In view of the foregoing information it is hereby requested that an exception to the No-Flare Order R-553 be approved for an indefinite period or until such time that the gas production shall have increased to a commercial volume.
