This form shall be completed by the operator of the well or the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission and shall be submitted from which oil or gas is produced. A separate report shall be filed as soon as a temporary authorization to transport oil or gas is issued. This report shall be approved by the Oil Conservation Commission and a copy shall be furnished to the transporter, one copy returned to the permittee and one copy retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be issued by the District Office upon a change in ownership and each change in the transportation of the oil or gas. In the event of a temporary change in the transporter involving less than one year, or an extension for one production period, the operator shall file a separate report with the Oil Conservation Commission District Office and the District Office shall be permitted to handle with the Commission by letter. The certificate shall be issued by the District Office to be moved by the transporter temporarily. The certificate shall be issued by the District Office to a temporary transporter and the certificate shall be issued by the District Office to a temporary transporter. Such temporary transporter shall be issued by the District Office and the estimated amount of oil or gas to be transported.

This certificate shall be issued by the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission and shall be submitted to the District Office for review and authorization to transport oil and gas. The certificate shall be issued by the District Office and shall remain in full force and effect until

- (a) The certificate is withdrawn.
- (b) The certificate is revoked.
- (c) The certificate is issued by the District Office.

If any of the rules of the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with, the District Office shall be notified, explained fully under the heading "REMARKS".

In all cases when a change in ownership or a change in the transporter of oil or gas, show under "REMARKS" the name of the transporter and the transporter previously authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate report shall be filed by the transporter and shall be designated by the Oil Conservation Commission.
