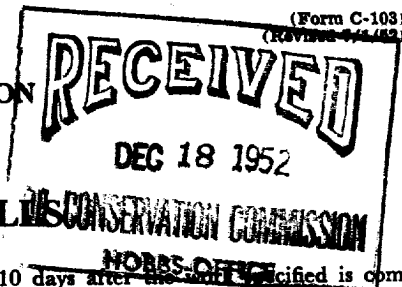

**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

To increase production from the State J-2 No. 6, the open-hole section from 3866' to 3869' was treated with 500 gallons acid. Prior to treating the well produced 25 barrels of oil and 17 barrels of water per day. It now produces 48 barrels oil, 16 barrels water, flowing thru 3/4" choke with 148 MCF gas. COR 3080.
