

Re: Application to Dually Complete Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda "F" No. 3, Jalmat Gas and South Eunice Oil Pools, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Gulf Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

- (a) That Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda "F" No. 3, located in the C SE/4 NW/4 of Section 4-22S-36E, is drilling and will be projected to an approximate depth of 3900'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on the Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda "F" Lease together with the location of all offset wells. The attached Exhibit "B" is a schematic drawing of the proposed dual completion.
- (b) That subject well will have $5\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set at approximately 3800' and cemented with 700 sacks of cement. The well is to be an oil well producing from the open hole interval from 3800-3900' in the Queen formation in the South Eunice Pool.
- (c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:
 - 1. Perforate the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " casing within the approximate interval of 3200-3500' in the Yates and Seven Rivers formations in the Jalmat Gas Pool.
 - 2. Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 3750' to separate the two pay zones.
 - 3. Produce the South Eunice Pool oil through the tubing and the Jalmat gas through the tubing-casing annulus.
- (d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Jalmat and oil from the South Eunice is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
- (e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
