Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Gulf Oil Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda "F" No. 9 located 1980' FSL and 1890' FEL of Section 4-22S-36E, will be completed as an oil well at an approximate total depth of 3900'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on the Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda "F" Lease together with the location of all offset wells. The attached Exhibit "B" shows a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.

(b) That subject well will have 5-1/2" casing set at 3900' and cemented with sufficient cement to isolate the salt section. The well will be an oil well producing from the perforated interval from approximately 3800-3850' from the Penrose formation in the South Eunice Pool.

(c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

- (1) Perforate the 5-1/2" casing within the approximate intervals of 3150-3350' in the Yates formation in the Jalmat Gas Pool.
- (2) Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 3750' to separate the two pay zones.
- (3) Produce the South Eunice Pool oil through the tubing and the Jalmat gas through the tubing casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Jalmat and oil from the South Eunice is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

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(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

(g) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.

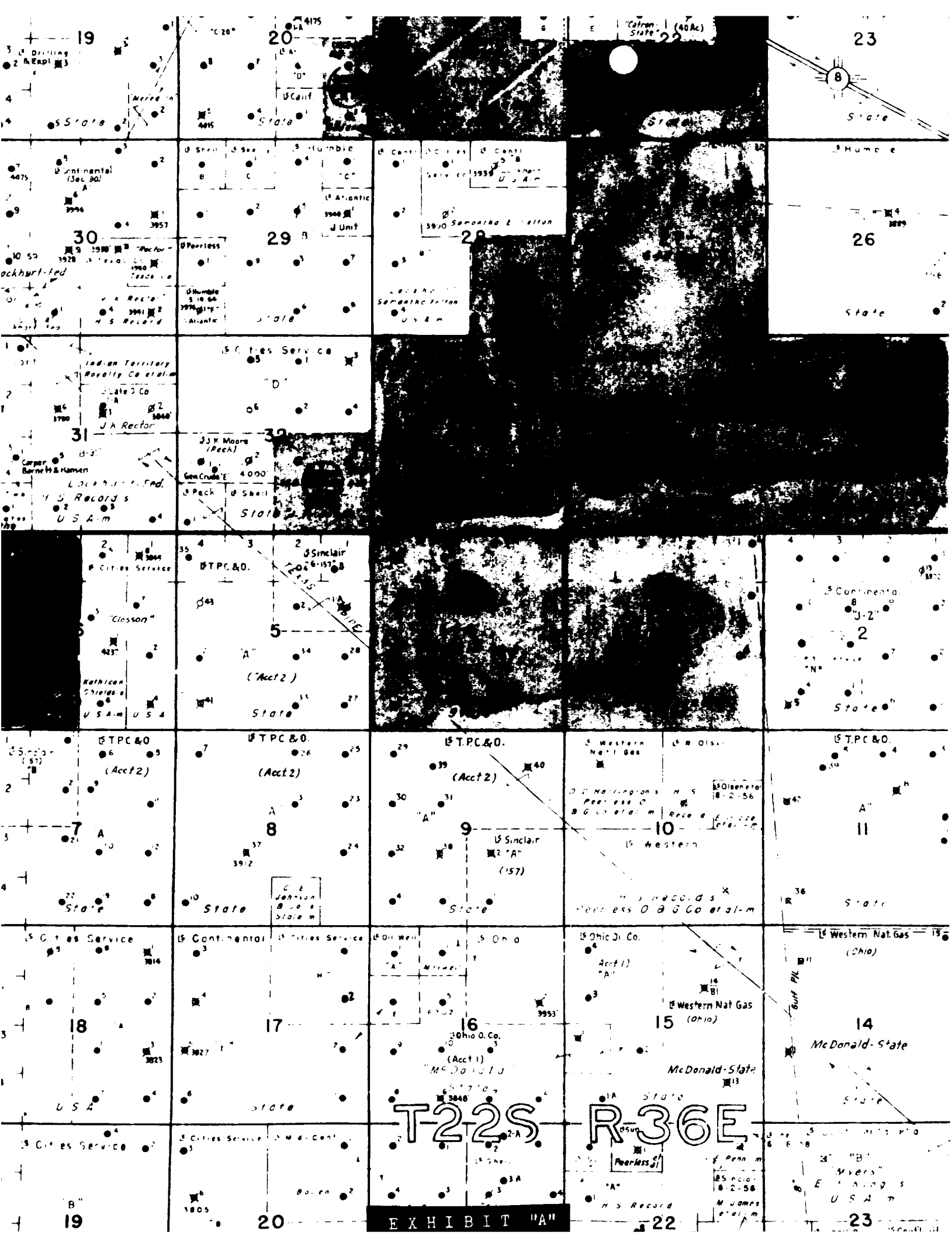


EXHIBIT "B"
