Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests your approval of our administrative application for the subject Unorthodox Gas Well Location and Simultaneous Dedication.

Chevron has just recently re-completed it's J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 16 in the Jalmat Tansil Yates Seven Rivers (Pro Gas) Pool. It is our desire to simultaneously dedicate an existing 600-acre Jalmat Gas Proration Unit assigned to our J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 13 (Order R-5523) to both the No. 16 and No. 13 wells. As a result, the location of the J. F. Janda Well No. 16 is unorthodox in that it is less than 990' from the outer boundary of the proration unit. The location of Well No. 16 is 1980 feet FNL and 660 feet FEL of Section 4, T-22-S, R-36-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

In order to prevent waste, Chevron respectfully requests your approval of this administrative application for an unorthodox gas well location and simultaneous dedication under the provisions of Rule 104 (F). Attached is a map showing offset
