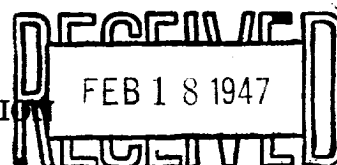

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We desire your approval to change the wells producing into tank batteries #2 & #5 on the above lease -

Battery #2, 3-H 500 bbl. tanks located on SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5-22S-36E, to which Shell Pipe Line is connected is now receiving the oil from 2 - 3 - 7 - 26 - 34 & 35. Wells #23, 25, 27, 28, 29, & 33 are now running into battery #5 on SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5-22S-36E and because #33 is now making water, we would like to connect this well into battery #2 where we are equipped to treat the oil.

Attached hereto is plat #1 which shows wells going into battery #2 & #5 at present time, and plat #2 shows the proposed change of #33 from battery #5 to battery #2.
