We would like your approval on tank battery change. We had a tank battery of 4, 500 barrel tanks in center of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 5-22S-36E. We have added one 500 bbl. tank to this battery, but divided same into two batteries, using the 3 west tanks for wells 2, 3, 5, & 7 and the 2 east tanks for wells 25, 26, 27, & (28 when completed.) We have one separator for each battery, with a header by each separator to enable individual well testing. The Shell Pipe Line has requested us to keep the two batteries at same location to save need for as little additional pipe as possible to connect to a battery at another location.
