FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We desire your approval to change tank batteries. At present we have a tank battery on SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 9, and a double battery of 5 tanks (or 2 batteries together) on SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5. On account of recent well completions in this area, we desire to move 3 tanks of the double battery to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5 which will shorten our flow lines from wells to tanks. We want to run wells 23, 25, 27, 28, & 29 into the new battery on SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5. This will leave wells 2, 3, 5, 7, 26, & 33 in the battery on SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5. The battery on SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9 to which Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line is connected, will receive the oil from wells 1, 4, 24, 30, 31, 32. It will be noted that wells 23 & 29 now being run by Texas-New Mexico battery on SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9, will be in the battery on SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5 to which Shell is to be connected.

The attached plat shows locations of batteries and wells.
