cemented with 200 sacks August 17, 1946. Drilled plug and pipe
with 1000# pump pressure before and after drilling plug August
19, 1946. Pipe tested O.K.

State "A" a/c-2, Well No. 34. Set 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe at 3768' 9",
cemented with 232 sacks August 30, 1946. Drilled plug and tested
pipe before and after drilling plug with 1100# pump pressure
September 1, 1946. Pipe tested O.K.
