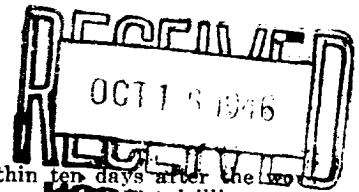

Run 277' of 12½" casing, set @ 287' cemented w/275 sacks, Sept. 11, 1946. Drilled plug and tested pipe w/700# pump pressure before and after drilling plug Sept. 12, 1946. Pipe tested O. K.

Run 3078' of 8 5/8" casing, set @ 3088' cemented w/250 sacks Sept. 19, 1946. Drilled plug and tested casing w/1000 # pump pressure before and after drilling plug, Sept. 22, 1946. Tested O.K.
