DETAILS OF WORK

Glosson No. 8 was originally completed as an oil well in 1937 and had produced approximately 154,000 barrels of oil by June, 1952 when it ceased to produce oil. A formation packer had been set in the open hole at 3112' in August, 1943 in order to shut off some of the gas so after the well ceased to produce oil from the formation below the packer, a choke was placed on the casing and it produced gas through the casing until December, 1952 when water encroachment killed the gas flow. It has been temporarily abandoned since that time.

It is proposed to plug off the over formation and attempt to re-complete as a gas well through casing perforations at approximately 3500'. Four other wells in the immediate area have successfully been recompleted as gas wells in this manner. The original well logs on No. 8 indicates gas shows from 3123' to 3127'

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I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
