July 6, 1939, 4 7/8" OD x 32" Rubber Exner-Dodge Underset Formation Packer was set at 3811'

July 11, 1939, acid treated with 1,000 gallons below the packer.

Production tests: Before, avg. 54 bbls oil daily with 1,329,825 cu. ft., gas, flowing thru 1/2" & 3/4" chokes wide open. (In 24 hrs)

After: Flowed 53 bbls oil (July 21st), thru 1/2" & 3/4" chokes wide open, with 285,000 cu. ft. gas.
