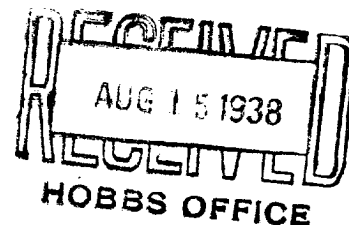

On August 11, 1938 the 8 5/8" 32# 10-thd second Hand National SS Grade "C" casing was cemented in anhydrite at 1699' 11" w/650 sacks 4% aquagel cement and 50 sacks neat cement by the Halliburton Cementing Process. Cement did not circulate into cellar, will dump additional cement in at top to fill.

Propose to drill the plug and test on August 13, 1938 at 330 AM.
