Gentlemen:

The Commission has reclassified the Tide Water Associated Oil Company's J.H. Day Well No. 1 as a Jalmat Pool Gas Well and will remove it from the Jalmat Gil proration schedule March 1, 1956. By this letter Tide Water requests the Coundssion to grant a 10 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Pool under Rule 5 (b) for this well. The following reasons justify approval of this request.

- 1. Applicant seeks a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the NE/4 of NW/4 of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NHPH, Lea County, New Mexico, and the allocation of an appropriate gas slicwable to said unit.
- 2. The well to which applicant seeks to have the allowable granted is the J.H. Day Well #1, located 660' from the North Line and 1980' from the West Line of said Section 6. All of the requested gas unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The attached plat shows the acreage to be dedicated outlined in red, the well location, and offset cwmarship.
- 4. The offset operators have been notified of this application by a copy of the same by registered mail. These operators are listed below:
 - a. Cities Service Cil Company
 - b. Gulf Oil Corporation
 - c. Two States Petroleum Company
 - d. Continental Oil Company
- 5. The granting of this non-standard proration unit will not adversly affect the correlative rights of any offset owners and will protect the correlative rights of the applicant and prevent waste.
- 6. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit is productive of gas. This statement is justified by the production history of the J.H. Day Well #1.

The Tide Water Associated Oil Company requests the Cil Conservation Commission to grant an administrative 40 acre non-standard proration unit for their J.H. Dey Well #1.
