This well was making an excessive amount of gas and very little fluid, the original Packer was pulled and another ran and set at 3807'. After Packer setting it was swabbed in and we have practically all the gas shut off and flowing 10 to 11-bbls fluid per day with approx. 5/10% BS&W. We plan on treating this well with 500-gallons of Dowell X Acid to increase the oil volume.
