DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After the Packer setting we had approx 150,000 Cu Ft Gas and about 15-Bbls fluid per day with estimated 2-Bbl water. Well was treated with 500-Gallons of acid, after swabbing in, and producing in pits for several hours well tested 14.26-bbls oil and 1.58-bbls water for 24-hours with 160,900 Cu Ft Gas.
