Re: Application for a Nonstandard Gas
Proration Unit to be Assigned
Sinclair's State 157 "B" Well No. 2
in the Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County,
New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company wishes to make this application for an
Administrative Order under Order R-520 which will establish a Nonstandard Gas
Proration Unit of 152.38 acres in the Jalmat Gas Pool to be assigned to subject
well.

In this connection Sinclair wishes to state:

1. Sinclair is the Operator of the State 157 "B"
Well No. 2 which is located in the SE/4 of the
the NW/4 of Section 7-22S-36E, Lea County, New
Mexico. This well was originally completed as
an oil well in the South Eunice Pool on May 12,
1938, and is therefore entitled to the 330 foot
location tolerance.
2. The proposed Nonstandard Unit consists of the
NW/4 of Section 7-22S-36E. Subject well is
located 990 feet from the South line and 330 feet
from the East line of the proposed unit. Subject
well was plugged back from the Queen and recompleted
in the Yates and Seven Rivers Gas zones on December 24,
1955 with an open flow potential of 6500 MCF per day.
3. The length or width of the proposed unit does not
exceed 5280 feet.
4. The proposed unit consists of contiguous quarter-
quarter sections and lies wholly within a single
governmental section.
5. The entire proposed unit may reasonably be presumed
to be productive of gas.
