DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled tubing and packer and cleaned out to TD. Seven Rivers formation was squeezed from 3831' to 3322' w/ 190 sacks 3% Gel and 6 sacks Stratocrete. The 7" casing was perforated in the Yates sand from 3150' to 3285' w/ 4 jet shots/ ft. and 2 open hole jet shots/ ft. On 4/3, the well was treated w/ 500 gals. 20% acid and on 4/4, it was treated w/ 2,000 gals. 15% acid. Swabbed dry so 3 batch hydrofrac job performed on 4/5.

Test before treatment: Well dead

Test after treatment: 350,000 CF/ day
