DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Perforated Seven Rivers formation with 4 jet shots per foot from 3590-3615' and 3560-3580'. Swabbed dry. Retainer set at 3400' and squeezed with 100 sacks 3% Gel and 2 sacks of Gel flakes. Top plug at 3380'. Shot Yates from 3180-3375' with 2 1/2 quarts nitro per foot. Bailed out 500' water when well blew itself out so tubing run back in under pressure. 2" tubing set at 3209' and packer at 2863'.

Test before treatment 180 MCF/day OBWPD

Test after Treatment 4450 MCF/day OBWPD
