## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We desire your approval to change tank batteries on our State "A" Ac. 2 lease, So. Eunice pool, replace tanks and rearrange wells into batteries to shorten lines, as follows:

Battery #1, 3 - 1000 bbl. tanks, located on SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 9-22S-36E, to which Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line Company will receive the oil from wells # 1-4-24-30-31-32.

Battery #2, 3 - H-500 bbl. tanks located on SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 5-22S-36E to which Shell Pipe Line is connected will receive the oil from wells 2-3-7-26-34. #34 is now starting drilling operations.

Battery #3, 2 - L-250 bbl. tanks located on NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 7-22S-36E, to which Shell Pipe Line is connected will receive the oil from wells 5-6-9 and 11.

Battery #4, 2 - H-500 bbl. tanks located on SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 7-22S-36E, to which Shell Pipe Line is connected will receive the oil from wells 8-10-12-19-20-21 and 22.

Battery #5, 3 - H-500 bbl. tanks located on SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 5-22S-36E, to which Shell Pipe Line is connected, will receive the oil from wells 23-25-27-28-29- and 33.

The attached plat shows location of batteries and well numbers to each battery.
