1. Pull tubing. Clean out to T.D. 3875'. Run casing scraper.
2. Run 4-1/2" hydril flush joint liner from 3695-3875' and cement.
3. Run logs (Gamma Ray-Neutron). Perforate where logs indicate.
4. Sand-oil treat with 20,000 gals. refined oil and 20,000# sand.
5. Test Well.
