DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was killed with salt water and the tubing was pulled. Then 3797' of 2" NHE tubing was run into the hole and the well dual completed by setting a packer at 3686' (see attached diagram). Perforations in the gas designated interval (3200' - 3230', 3255' - 3285', 3605' - 3630', 3640' - 3660' and 3670' - 3684') produced 1302 MCFFD with a 12 hour shut-in pressure of 670#. The perforated interval in the oil designated interval (3715' - 3799') produced 250 MCFFD with a 12 hour shut-in pressure of 625# and no oil.
