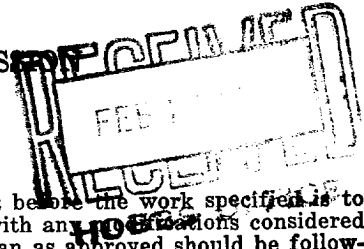


NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION **SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO** **MISCELLANEOUS NOTICES**
