Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the assignment of a gas allowable for the above-captioned well which was recently re-worked as a producer in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

Information available to us from our Hobbs office indicates that representatives of your company did not file the proper forms on this well until November 23, 1955, even though the well was re-worked and on production on August 1, 1955. We realize that your delay in filing these forms was due to personnel changes within your organization and because of this fact we are assigning the well a current allowable retro-active to August 1, 1955, and attached hereto is a sheet showing the current allowable assigned and the production reported for the months available.

The well will be listed on the December gas proration schedule with an assignment of a 320-acre proration unit and the October net allowable as indicated on the attached sheet.
