APPLICATION

Comes now Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company, by its attorney, pursuant to Rule 112-A of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico and requests administrative approval for the dual completion of its N. M. State "A" a/c-2 Well #38 located 1980' from the south and west lines of Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and on behalf of its application states:

(1) There is attached hereto a plat showing the location of all wells in Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 36 East.

(2) The well here involved was completed March 13, 1947 at a total depth of 3845'. The well was plugged back to 3823' and casing was set at 3794'.

(3) It is proposed that a packer be set at approximately 3550'. There are perforations in the gas-designated interval at 3105'-3135', 3160'-3200', and 3510'-3540' and gas will be produced through the casing at these points. The oil interval is perforated at 3650'-3715', 3735'-3780', and 3794'-3823' (open-hole) and oil will be produced through the tubing at these points.

(4) The well has a present allowable of 6 barrels of oil per day and a gas-oil ratio of 415,145 to 1.

(5) This will be a gas-oil dual completion. The well will first be killed and the tubing pulled. The casing will be tested for leaks. The packer will be set in such a manner that prescribed tests may be taken.
