Recent tests of our State "A" A/c 2, Well #38 located in the South Eunice Pool shows that the well will make an amount of oil that will average one barrel per day with a GOR of 45,800.

In the past this well has been used to furnish gas for gas lift purposes and sale of gas. The well has now been taken out of the gas lift system and is producing into the battery along with the other wells and the gas is being sold with the other gas.

In order to properly assign the oil and gas production from this well it is requested that we be allowed to change the status of the well from gas well to oil well.
